Under the Awards' 1st cycle for the year 2026, the **Golden Peacock Awards Secretariat, Institute of Directors, India** invited applications for the following Institutional awards from Corporates, including both large enterprises and SMEs, covering all types of Public, Private, and Government Enterprises from India and abroad:

1. **Golden Peacock Award for Excellence in ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (GPAAEI)**
2. **Golden Peacock INNOVATIVE PRODUCT/SERVICE Award (GPIPSA)**
3. **Golden Peacock National QUALITY Award (GPNQA)**
4. **Golden Peacock BUSINESS EXCELLENCE Award (GPBEA)**
5. **Golden Peacock National TRAINING Award (GPNTA)**

These prestigious awards aim to recognise and celebrate organisations that have demonstrated outstanding achievements in various areas of Artificial Intelligence, Innovation, Quality Management, Business Excellence and Learning & Development practices.

This year, the **Secretariat received over 511 responses**, for the above annual Golden Peacock Awards.

After careful scrutiny, **206 applications were shortlisted** across various business sectors for final selection, through a rigorous 3-tier Assessment Process. The quality of the shortlisted entries clearly reflected the immense commitment of the participating organizations to strive for excellence and their desire to maintain world-class quality standards.

An Assessment Group, consisting of experts in Artificial Intelligence, Innovation, Quality Management, Business Excellence and Learning & Development, was established to evaluate the applications. Each application was independently reviewed by assessors, who thoroughly analyzed the submissions. Following this, a peer review by the committee was conducted to ensure consistency, transparency, and fairness in the selection process. This process underlined the high standards of the Golden Peacock Awards and the focus on recognizing excellence in corporate practices.

Review Parameters/Criteria:

The applications, submitted on self-assessment parameters, were evaluated on a total score of 1000 marks. **A final cut-off of 80% was applied**, ensuring that only the highest-quality submissions were considered for the awards.

Among the shortlisted applicants, the organisation with the highest score in each respective Business Sector was recommended to the Jury for their final decision.

The selection process highlights the commitment of the awardees to achieve excellence in innovative Artificial Intelligence, Innovation, Quality Management, Business Excellence and Learning & Development practices.
